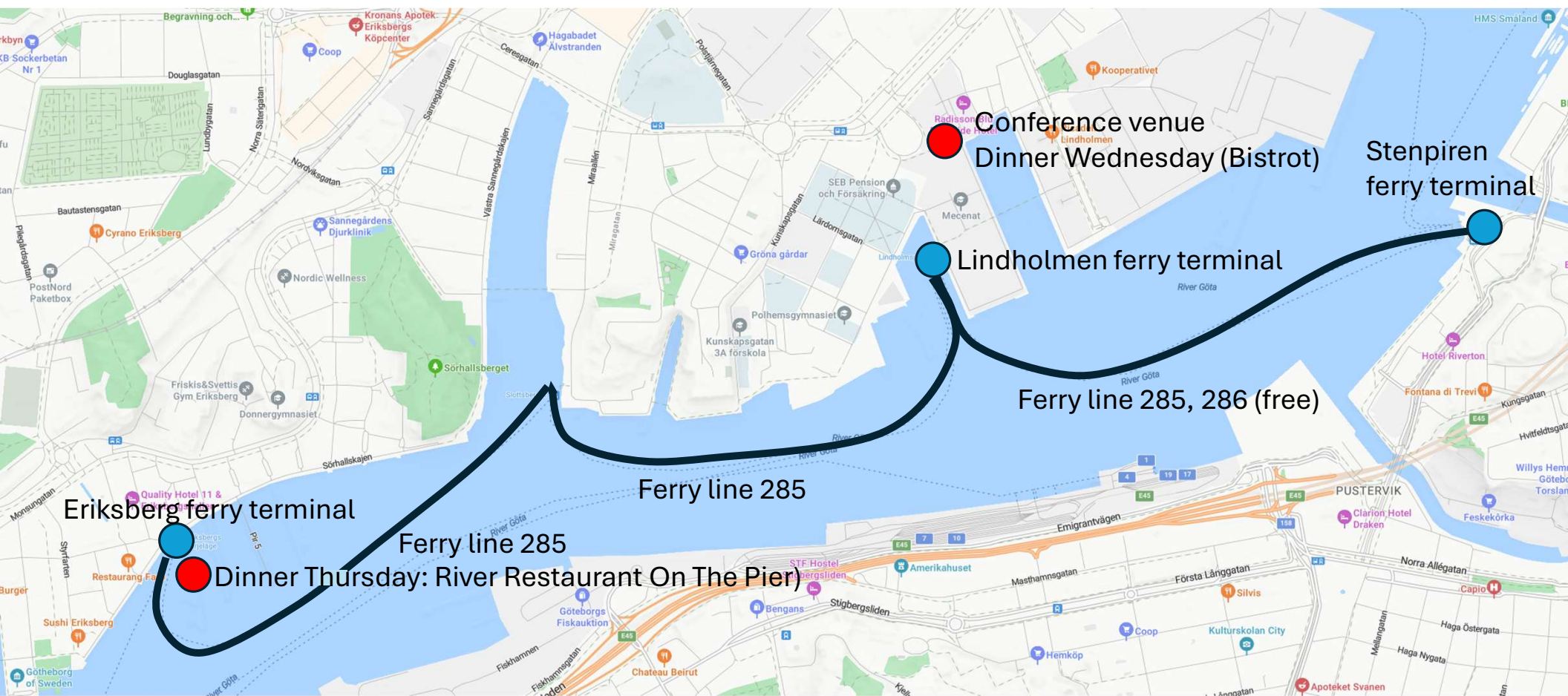

How to get around IMP ?



- Ferry line 286: Älvsnabbare is free and connects Stenpiren and Lindholmen (conference venue) between 6 am and 7 pm. **Green flag.**
- Ferry line 285 connects Stenpiren and Lindholmen (conference venue) and Eriksberg (dinner Thursday). You can 'blip' your Visa or Master Card to pay. **Orange flag.**
- It is a 30 minute walk from the conference center (Lindholmen) to Eriksberg – River Restaurant on The Pier (Thursday dinner) – we will arrange 'Walking teams' from the conference venue and also guide you at the ferry terminal for those who prefer ferry.
- To travel with bus and tram – 'blip' your creditcard for one adult within central Gothenburg. The ticket is valid 90 minutes.

Bike on Älvsnabben

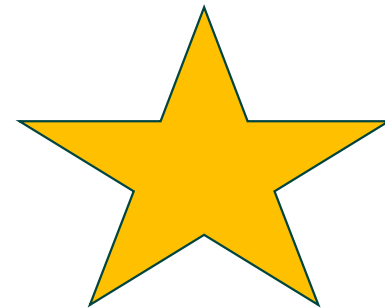
There is room for bicycles on the fore deck on board at Älvsnabben. Guests can bring bicycles free of charge.
